## Board Policies Colorado Court Reporters Association Revised September 2018

- 1. CCRA will provide for the cost of the President's room at the spring and fall general meeting.
- 2. Complaints should be sent to the Ethics Committee, not the board or officers.
- 3. In order to be in the CCRA Membership Directory, dues must be paid by June 1 of each year.
- 4. NCSA delegates and alternates are to be reimbursed for one night's lodging and airfare as necessitated by their attendance at the NCSA meeting.
- 5. The financial statement will be presented at each board meeting by the Secretary-Treasurer or Executive Director.
- 6. If an NCRA representative attends the spring and/or fall meeting of CCRA, the NCRA representative will be reimbursed in accordance with NCRA policy.
- 7. The books of the association are to be reviewed by an accountant or audit committee at no greater than two-year intervals.
- 8. The President and Vice President, unless other members are otherwise designated by the Executive Committee, will be reimbursed for airfare and lodging when attending the NCRA leadership conference.
- 9. Honorary members may attend all CCRA functions at a 50% discount.
- 10. One night's lodging will be paid during any seminar for the Executive Director if overnight stay is required. (Revised 9/9/2018)
- 11.Only officers of the corporation may sign contracts.

- 12.Board members may be reimbursed for mileage expenses for travel exceeding 100 miles to attend board meetings and shall be up to half of the standard IRS mileage deduction. (Revised 9/9/2018)
- 13.Cancellation policy: Upon written notice received seven days prior to an event, refunds will be granted less a processing fee. Other refunds are subject to Executive Committee review.
- 14. Board approval is need for any unbudgeted expenditure over \$500. (Passed 6/4/1995)
- 15.All CCRA policies shall include a date of implementation and rationale, and are to be reviewed annually. (Passed 6/4/1995)
- 16.If requested, board members and fundraising chair may receive a 20% reduction on registration fees for seminars. Rationale: Board members are fundraising chair are highly encouraged to attend all CCRA functions, therefore, incurring higher expenses than might otherwise be had. (Revised 9/9/2018)
- 17.Ramblings and social media advertising will not be allowed for entities offering continuing education points or credits. Rationale: Competes and often corresponds at the same time as CCRA sponsored CE events. (Revised 9/9/2018)
- 18.Reporters have to show verification that they are a current member of their home state association in order to get the member rate to attend CCRA seminars. Rationale: To promote good will and active participation in state associations. (Passed 1/28/2017)
